## NATIONAL HISTORIC PRESERVATION ACT SECTION 106

- •Requires federal agencies to
  - Take into account the effects of their undertakings on cultural resources
  - Afford the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation a reasonable opportunity to comment
- Public involvement is a key ingredient
- Encourages maximum coordination with NEPA
  - Cultural resources must also be considered under NEPA
