



New Visitor Services for **MISSION SAN JUAN DEMONSTRATION FARM**



Why Proposed Changes are Needed:

- The San Juan Demonstration Farm will provide visitors an opportunity to experience a simulated Spanish colonial labore (farm field) immediately adjacent to Mission San Juan.
- Changes needed to illustrate Spanish colonial farming technology and practices, with a focus on acequias (irrigation ditches).

Proposed Changes

- Construction of necessary visitor services for the demonstration farm, including a maintenance facility, realignment of roadways and parking, restrooms, offices, and a visitor contact station with exhibit areas.

Environmental Assessment:

- To comply with applicable environmental regulations, the National Park Service (NPS) must analyze effects of these proposed changes on the human and natural environment in an Environmental Assessment (EA).
- The EA requires public input on the proposed changes as well as other alternatives.
- Three alternatives for the changes at the San Juan Demonstration farm are being considered.

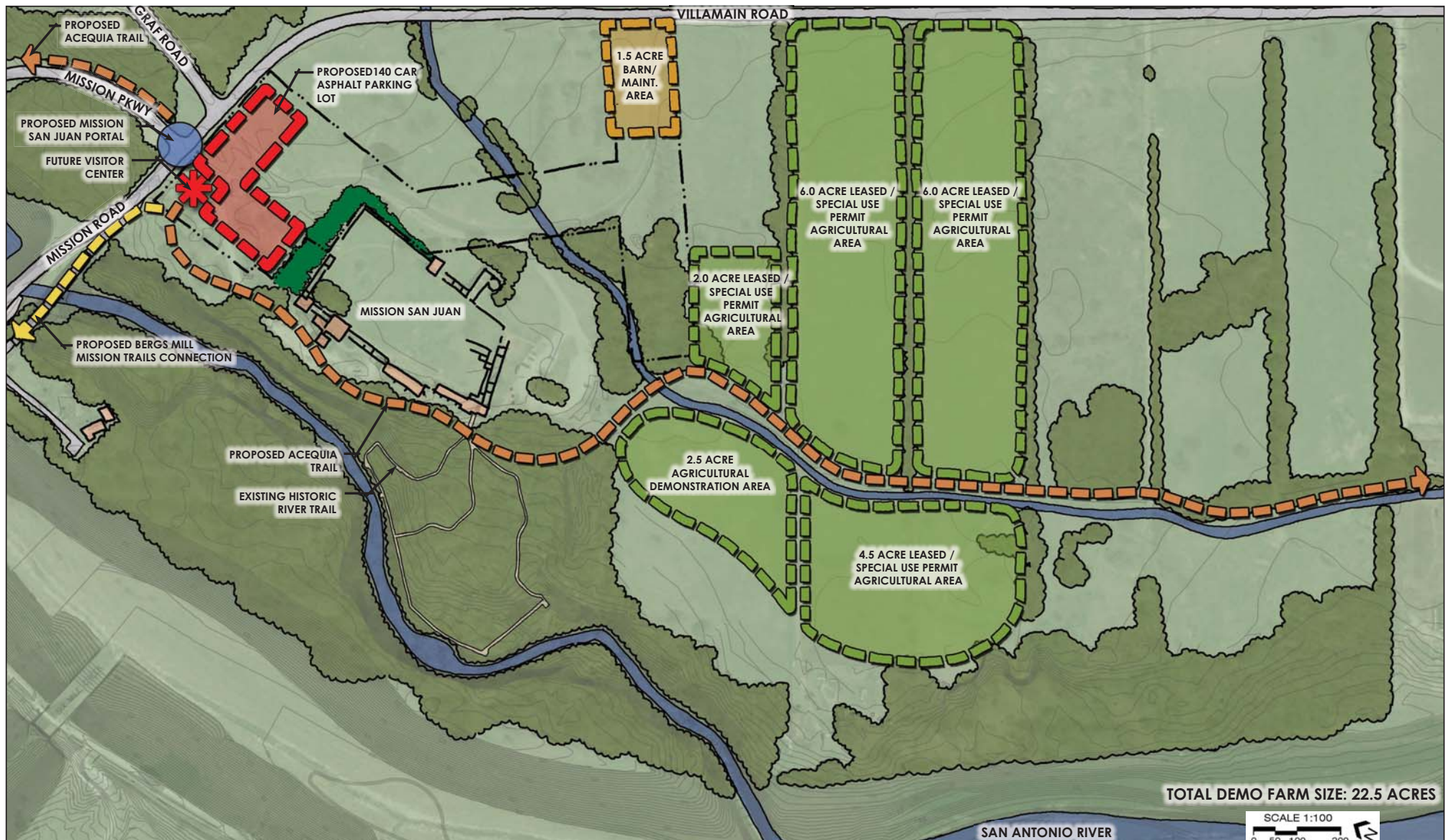
